Tara and Boyne Centre trip - 13 September 2008 - *Booking Now!*

As set out in Newsletter 6, the Federation and the National Federation of Local History Societies have arranged a joint visit to Tara and the new Boyne Centre, on Saturday 13 September.

Local Society members are invited to book places now. The programme will be:

10:30 am Tara - tour and lecture on the history and development of the site with input from local historical interests and information about the historical evidence emerging from the current controversial motorway works.

12 noon: Lunch: Slane

2:00 pm: Boyne Centre - Tour of the new Centre and lecture on the Battle and its significance.

5:00 pm: End of tour

Costs: The cost, including bus and lunch, will be £25/ \in 33.

Note: For Members in Monaghan, Cavan and Donegal who do not use the transport provided the cost of the Tara/ Boyne Centre event will be €15.00

Transport: A coach will leave Castledawson roundabout at (7.30am), calling at Glengall Street, Belfast, (8.15am), The Coach Inn, Banbridge (9:00am) and Five Ways roundabout, Newry (9:30 am) (Times to be confirmed)

Special Needs: Any special dietary needs should be provided on the Booking Form enclosed.

Numbers: Numbers are limited to 50 per Federation so it is essential to post or email the completed Booking Form to the Federation at the above address as quickly as possible.

Societies on the Web

About 60 societies have no web presence or access to electronic mail. The Executive Committee has decided to offer the opportunity for these Societies to get online. Access to email and the web would assist with their research, improve their communications and increase their reach. It would also reduce the time and costs of printing and postage and speed up communication with and between the Executive Committee and the members.

On offer is a basic package of five web pages; a home page, events page, contacts page, local publications page and a photos page, hosted on the Federation's website. Each Society would have its own domain name e.g. www.cloughhistory.org.uk and email address eg. cloughhistory@fuls.org.uk. The site would be designed in agreement with the individual society.

The set-up costs to participating Societies would be £35.00 (including the web address and the email address). Ongoing costs would be £15 in year two (for the email address) and £25 in year three (for the renewal of the domain name as well as the email address), £15 in year 4 and thereafter repeating the pattern. These costs would be added to the membership fee of that Society. The Federation would provide an update service free of charge.

Societies might regard this as an interim step to a full website. In this event the Federation would assist with the migration.
