Proposed Tour to USA, 2009

Following the successful tours to the U.S.A. in 2004 and 2007, the Society is proposing a follow-up tour to the United States in the Autumn (Fall) of 2009. This will coincide with the "Fall Festival" in New England, when the leaves on the trees turn to all colours of gold, orange, bronze and every other colour in that range that you can imagine.

We plan to fly from Dublin to Boston and the proposed dates are from the 4th to the 18th of October, 2009, inclusive.

The trip will include day excursions to Boston and to Salem to see their historic sights and we'll stay just west of the city in Marlborough for eight nights. Tours will include the Mohawk Trail and historic Sturbridge where we shall visit the 'Olde Worlde' village there. Next we move to Plymouth for five nights to learn all about the Plymouth Rock, Cape Cod, Martha's Vineyard - the playground of the Kennedy Clan. Then it's back to Boston for a shopping round-up before we fly back to Ireland.

This is only an outline itinerary and of course if we manage to make it all happen, when the final arrangements are complete, full details will be confirmed.

It is expected that the cost will be in the region of £1650, which will include all air travel, coaching, accommodation, admission fees and some meals. The final cost may have to be adjusted if the exchange rate of Sterling v U.S. dollar changes significantly.
