Researching Derry & Londonderry Ancestors is a CD-ROM that will help people trace their ancestors within the county.

The information on the CD is presented within a website which covers the range of sources necessary to trace ancestors in the county and indicates where they can be accessed. In order to provide more detailed examples of the sources and demonstrate how they can be used to research the history of a family, the CD includes case studies of families and localities drawn from different parts of the county.

The CD also contains maps showing the distribution of the baronies, parishes and other administrative divisions in the county at various times in the past. Included is a database where you can search for any townland within the county and see in which barony, parish, etc. it was located.

A key feature of the CD is the inclusion of databases covering the period 1622-1859 which will allow you to search for surnames throughout the county at various times in the past. Also, by including many links to online databases and family history websites, the CD serves as a gateway to researching family history on the Internet.
