Report on AGM 2020 replacement process

As you know, the Pandemic stopped all location-based activities in its tracks, so it was not possible to hold the normal Annual General Meeting.

The Executive Committee knew that, in the absence of an AGM, there would be questions of legitimacy for them to carry on into another year without getting the views of the members, so it was agreed to put the essence of a physical meeting to the members to ask for approval.

A questionnaire was circulated, enclosing the normal papers including the Minutes of AGM 2019, Trustees' Report, and Statement of Accounts for the 2019-20 Financial year, Secretary's and Treasurer's Reports, the reappointment of the Auditor, and approval for the existing Officers and Executive Committee to continue in office until the next AGM.

23 Societies responded and agreed with all the recommendation.
